CAR FACTS...

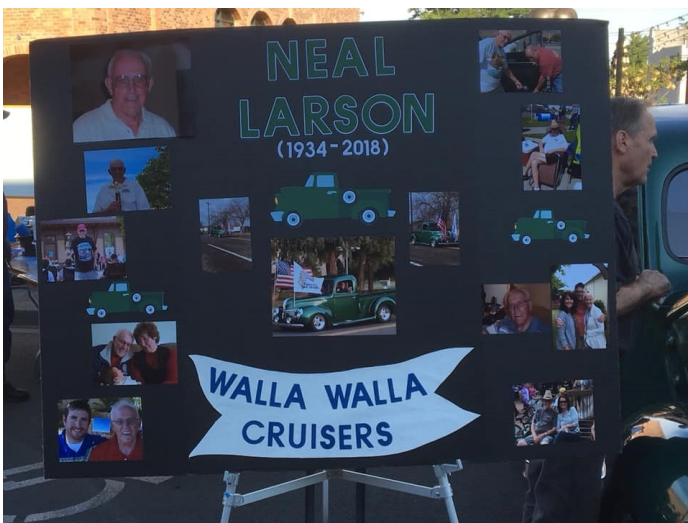
